Taken from Andrew Chapman's journal:

"November 1819 Redmon Cruse ct (credit?) to one gallon and a half of Brandy one dollar fifty cents."

"Read by the hand of George Cruse one gallon of whiskey 25 cents of the above account."

"June the 1st 1822 William Jackson ct to twenty one pounds of Bacon one dollar seventy cents."

"William Jackson ct by breaking flax one (dollar?) seventy five cents."

(The following entries are X'd out: debts paid?)

"May the seventh 1832 David Chapman ct to John Chapman to borrow money six dollars sixty two and a half cents."

"To 50 fifty cents paid me Norman."

"July 27th 1831 James Marmertry (sp?) to twenty five pounds of Bacon two dollars fifty cents."

"Read by the hand of Owin Biggers one dollar fifty cents of the above account."

"Read the whole amount by Jesse Biggers"

"May 1832 (22?) William Dewhitt cr by fifty six pounds of bacon five dollars sixty cents."

"William Dewhitt cr by two dollars sixty two and a half cents."

"By one dollar in silver"

"By seventy 5 cents"

"August 1822 Richard Lamb cr to John Chapman to one gun four dollars in silver."

"six pounds of coffee one dollar 50 cents

two.....hankercheifs 75 cents

two files 25 cents

three pounds of coffee 75 cents

seven....cotton one dollar ?? cents

one...knife 121/2 cents

spinning.....one dollar  
one yard callico 25 cents  
bushel salt one dollar (signed by) David H Chapman

January 12th 1849 Erastus Ferguson dbt to James Chapman 75 cents for wagon and steers."

James Chapman born 1780 will

"In the name of God, I James Chapman being old and feeble in body but sound in mind make this my last will and testamony that upon my death, my wife Mary is to have of my property as....1st. She shall have the best bed and sted and sufficient....cloths for the same and this best chest that I own and...the bed cloths that she brought to my house and all she has made since she has been living with . This I desire, she is to have and her maintainance all provided for her, fully shown in a deed and obligation between me and Robert Chapman. This 2nd day of March 1867. James Chapman
