CAD was the "original" source for the parents of George Chapman. OneWordTree (OWT) at [www.ancestry.com](http://www.ancestry.com) confirms those listed in this record. OWT does not show the parents of William Chapin but the parents of Mary Froggatt are Henry Froggatt and Elizabeth Furniss.

Most of the information on this family came from "DURRETT FAMILY" by Mrs. Bert Harter of Key West, Florida. Apparently parts of the work have appeared in a variety of publications. The part used here was in THE VIRGINIA GENEALOGIST and was titled "Robert Durrett of Spotsylvania Co., VA" This work has numerous footnotes with source data so where applicable the source they cited is used in this record.

Some of the information on this family comes from "Reprint from the Filson Club Historical Quarterly" YOUNG FAMILY, page 673. The DURRETT FAMILY referenced this as "YOUNG FAMILY" by Asa D. Young as published in THE REGISTER OF THE KENTUCKY HISTORICAL SOCIETY, v. 52, pp 45-49.

According to "family records," George Chapman was killed by Indians while migrating to Kentucky.

In Caroline Co. VA., on 14 Oct, 1781 Mrs. Diana Chapman acknowledged a deed from her husband, George, to Benja. Carter. (Caroline Co. VA., Minute Book 1774-81, p. 322.)

Read Robert Kincaid's "The Wilderness Road" for an outstanding report on the hazards faced by those moving through the Cumberland Gap during this period.

Bean's Station, near which George Chapman is supposed to be buried, is on the Tennessee loop of the trail going from Virginia to the Cumberland Gap. One route dipped down from Sapling Grove (now Bristol) to Long Island (now Kingsport) to Rogersville, Bean's Station, Tazewell and then the gap. Bean's Station was at the southern most part of the loop. The Virginia Loop went from Sapling Grove to The Block House, to Moccasin Gap, Natural Tunnell, Glade Spring, Martin's Station and then the Gap.

Bean's Station was a key stop over for the first large group of settlers moving from North Carolina into Kentucky- after Daniel Boone and his men cleared the trail. It was a key point in the first mail delivery through the Cumberland Gap into Kentucky, Was an important position in the Civil War and was one of the sites involved with the Tennessee Valley Authority.
